Mayor Rigg called the Regular meeting of the City Council of Jefferson, South Dakota, to order. Motion to approve the agenda by Lokhorst second by Stokely. Motion carried. Motion to approve the minutes of the January 5, 2026, City Council meeting by Casper second by Nelkie. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Mayor Rigg recognized CM Nelkie. CM Nelkie has been working with Jesse Poore, AICP, Transportation Planner with Felsburg, Holt & Ullevig discussing a safety study for transportation. The study focuses on vehicle crashes, any fatalities, and safety issues such as cross walks, signage, sidewalks, and speeding. This study should conclude by June 1, 2026. A survey is available. Participation with honest feedback could result in grant money for road safety. A discussion followed as to the best way to get the survey out to the residents of Jefferson to get their input. FO Roark stated she is going to be sending the annual letter out and could include information about this online survey to area residents. CM Nelkie will send the FO an informative letter explaining the survey and the goal of same.

NEW BUSINESS:

Brad Antonson with Jensen Insurance, Beresford, South Dakota, was next on the agenda to conduct our annual insurance review. Mr. Antonson noted there was a decrease in premiums of \$543.00 for this year. The annual review covers Property, Liability, Crime/Fidelity, Inland Marine, Automobile, Umbrella, Cyber Solutions, Linebacker and Law Enforcement coverage. All aspects of the coverage from EMC were discussed. The City, Fire Department and Ambulance Department pay their share of the annual premium. Mayor Rigg and the City Council thanked Mr. Antonson for the review and information. CM Stokely asked about the Days of '59, how coverage is handled when someone wants to participate. A discussion followed.

The FO advised the City Council that SDML Workers Compensation contracted with Discovery Systems to perform a payroll audit for 2025. The FO sent Discovery Systems the information they requested.

Nominating petitions and pertinent dates were discussed.

Boards of Equalization will be held the third week of March. Motion by Casper to set aside March 18, 2026, starting at 6:30 p.m. for Boards of Equalization second by Stokely. Motion carried.

Spring clean up was discussed. The City Council decided to hold Spring clean up April 17, 18 and 19, 2026. The number of dumpsters was discussed, and an additional one will be ordered this year.
